**STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT
FOR SURRENDER OF MEDICAL LICENSURE**

THIS STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT is made and executed by Alvin E. Johnson, M.D. (Dr. Johnson), a physician licensed as of the date hereof to practice medicine in the state of Louisiana, with and in favor of the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners (Board).

1.

Acknowledgements and Stipulations

Dr. Johnson hereby acknowledges, stipulates and agrees that:

- (a) Investigation conducted by and on behalf of the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners indicates that, for an extended period of time, Dr. Johnson has been, by his own admission, treating his wife for various medical complaints with an increasing quantity of Demerol, a potent narcotic analgesic classified as a Schedule II controlled substance under state and federal law.
- (b) By his subscription hereto, Dr. Johnson also acknowledges that if the foregoing were proven at formal evidentiary hearing, he may be subject to licensure sanctions for "prescribing, dispensing or administering habit-forming or other legally controlled substances in other than a legal or legitimate manner, LSA-R.S. 37:1285(A)(6) and "continuing and recurring medical practice which fails to satisfy the prevailing and usually accepted standards of medical practice in this state," LSA-R.S. 37:1285(A)(14), among others.

- (c) Recognizing his right to have notice of such allegations and charges asserted against him, to administrative adjudication of such charges pursuant to LSA-R.S. 49:955-58, and to a final decision rendered upon written findings of fact and conclusions of law, Dr. Johnson, nonetheless, hereby waives his right to notice of charges and formal adjudication and, pursuant to LSA-R.S. 49:955D consents to entry of the order set forth hereinafter. By his subscription hereto, Dr. Johnson also hereby authorizes the Investigating Officer designated by the Board with respect hereto to present this Stipulation and Agreement for Surrender of Medical Licensure to the Board for its consideration and to fully disclose to and discuss with the Board the nature and results of the investigation, without prejudice to any future proceedings in the event that this stipulation is not accepted by the Board in its present form.

2.

Voluntary Surrender of Licensure

Notwithstanding his right to an administrative hearing and decision thereon, in recognition of the stipulations set forth hereinabove, toward final disposition of the investigation herein, Dr. Johnson hereby voluntarily surrenders to the Board, for cancellation, his license to practice medicine in the state of Louisiana, as evidenced by Certificate Number 005013.

3.

Effective Surrender of License

Dr. Johnson acknowledges, stipulates and agrees that the surrender of his medical licensure effected hereby shall have, and be deemed by the Board to have the same effect as if the Board had entered an order of revocation upon the conclusion of formal administrative proceedings. Dr. Johnson further acknowledges, stipulates and agrees that notice of Dr. Johnson's surrender of his medical license pursuant hereto, together with a certified copy of this stipulation and agreement, may be provided by the Board to the medical licensing agency of any state that may request information concerning the status of Dr. Johnson's Louisiana medical licensure, to the Federation of State Medical Boards of the United States, Inc., and to other persons, firms, associations, corporations and entities with a reasonable and legitimate need for such information as determined in the sole discretion of the Board.

Surrender of Controlled Substances Permits

Dr. Johnson, further, stipulates and agrees that within thirty (30) days from date of his execution hereof, he will surrender to the state and federal issuing authorities, his controlled substances permits and that he shall not, at any time hereafter, petition nor seek reinstatement or renewal of said state or federal controlled substances permits from the respective state and federal issuing authorities.
