(Certificate No. 13359R), Respondent **CONSENT ORDER** 

The above-entitled matter was docketed for investigation by the Investigating Officer of the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners (the "Board"). Lisa Marie Campeau, M.D. ("Dr. Campeau") is a physician who at all times pertinent has been licensed to engage in the practice of General Surgery in and around Covington, Louisiana.

An investigation was initiated based on information that Dr. Campeau had been arrested and charged with DUI in 2008. During the Board's investigation, Dr. Campeau took a medical leave of absence from her employment, and her hospital privileges expired. She subsequently signed a monitoring contract with the Physicians' Health Foundation of Louisiana and was deemed able to safely return to the practice of medicine, but elected not to re-apply for hospital privileges. Instead, she became employed in a non-clinical, academic setting where she has also been monitored by her employers.

As evidenced by her subscription to this Order, Dr. Campeau acknowledges the substantial accuracy of the forgoing information and that such acknowledgment and the reported information would provide the Investigating Officer assigned to this matter by the Board with probable cause to pursue administrative proceedings against her for violation of the Louisiana Medical Practice Act, La. Rev. Stat. §37:1285 (A) (5)<sup>1</sup>, constituting sufficient cause for action against her license to practice medicine in the State of Louisiana. Nonetheless, it is the recommendation of the Investigating Officer respecting the pending investigation, that the Board's responsibility to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of this state against the unprofessional, unqualified and unsafe practice of medicine, La. Rev. Stat. §37:1261, will be effectively served by entry of the Order set forth hereinafter by consent.

Stat. §37:1285A: (5), "[H]abital or recurring abuse of drugs, including alcohol, which affect the central nervous system and which are capable of inducing physiological or psychological dependence."

Recognizing her right to written notification of any charges that may be asserted against her as a result of this investigation, as well as the right to administrative adjudication of such charges, at which time she would be entitled to be represented by legal counsel, to call witnesses and to present evidence in defense or in mitigation of the charges made and to a decision thereon by the Board based upon written findings of fact and conclusions of law, pursuant to La. Rev. Stat. §§49:951 et seq. Dr. Campeau, nonetheless, hereby waives her rights to notice, formal adjudication and written decision and, pursuant to La. Rev. Stat. §49:955(D), consents to entry of the Order set forth hereinafter. Furthermore, Dr. Campeau acknowledges that she hereby waives any right to which she may be entitled pursuant to the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act. La. Rev. Stat. §§49:951 et seq., or to which she otherwise may be afforded by any law to contest her agreement to or the force and effect of the Board's investigation or this document in any court or other forum. By her subscription hereto, Dr. Campeau also hereby authorizes the I/O to present this Consent Order to the Board for its consideration and to fully disclose to and discuss with the Board the nature and results of the investigation and she waives any objection to such disclosures under La. Rev. Stat. §49:960. Dr. Campeau expressly acknowledges that the disclosure of such information to the Board by the I/O shall be without prejudice to the I/O's authority to proceed with the filing and adjudication of any administrative charges that may subsequently be filed in this matter against her, or to the Board's capacity to adjudicate such complaint should the Board decline to approve this Consent Order. Accordingly, in consideration of the forgoing and pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by La. Rev. Stat. §49:955(D);

IT IS ORDERED that the license of Lisa Marie Campeau, M.D. to engage in the practice of medicine in the State of Louisiana, as evidenced by Certificate No. 03923R, shall be RESTRICTED and LIMITED subject to her acceptance and strict compliance with the following terms, conditions and restrictions:

- (1) Board Approval of Practice. Dr. Campeau shall not engage in the clinical practice of medicine in this state unless and until the Board, in its sole discretion, issues and serves on Dr. Campeau a written decision approving her intended practice.
- (2) Evaluation and/or Demonstration of Competence. Before Dr. Campeau may petition the Board for removal or modification of this restriction, she must demonstrate to the Board her physical and psychological fitness and clinical competency through assessment at a program or facility approved in advance by the Board, or its designee. She must further demonstrate to the Board in writing that she has successfully completed any recommended remediation or training.
- (3) Personal Appearance Before the Board or Designee. In connection with a request to return to clinical practice, Dr. Campeau shall contact the Board at least sixty (60) days in advance of her date of desired return to clinical practice and arrange a personal appearance before the Board or its designee. At such meeting, Dr. Campeau shall demonstrate her compliance with the terms imposed by this Order, and she shall discuss with the Board or its designee her intentions with respect to the practice of medicine.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any violation or failure of strict compliance with any of the terms and conditions set forth by this Order by Dr. Campeau shall be deemed adequate and sufficient cause, upon proof of such violation or failure, for the revocation and cancellation of Dr. Campeau's license to practice medicine in the State of Louisiana or for such other action as the Board may deem appropriate, as if such violations were enumerated among the causes provided in La. Rev. Stat. § 37:1285.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Consent Order shall be, and shall be deemed to be, a public record.
