CONSENT ORDER

Jay P. Jaikishen, M.D. ("Dr. Jaikishen"), is, and at all times pertinent hereto, has been a physician licensed to practice medicine in the State of Louisiana, as evidenced by License Number 08029R. Dr. Jaikishen practices in the fields of internal medicine and nuclear medicine in and around Lafayette, Louisiana.

Dr. Jaikishen first came to the Board's attention when it received information that Dr. Jaikishen had entered into medical malpractice settlement. Board investigators met with Dr. Jaikishen to discuss the matter. The Board then received additional information that a second lawsuit was filed against Dr. Jaikishen alleging intentional conduct (by the same patient in the medical malpractice action). Board investigators reviewed documents related to that lawsuit and pertinent medical records, conducted interviews, and met with Dr. Jaikishen.

The Board's investigation suggested that Dr. Jaikishen's medical records did not adequately support some of his diagnoses and treatment decisions with respect to his care for the patient and the patient's family members. The investigation also suggested that Dr. Jaikishen had overstepped professional boundaries regarding the family's care, including inappropriately involving himself in the family's personal lives.

Predicated upon the information outlined above, the Director of Investigations ("DOI") of the Board has determined that reasonable cause exists to pursue administrative proceedings against Dr. Jaikishen for violation of the Louisiana Medical Practice Act, La. Rev. Stat. §37:1285(A)(13)¹ and (14).²

¹ Pursuant to La. R.S. §37:1285A(13), the Board may suspend, revoke, or impose probation or other restrictions on the license of an individual licensed to practice medicine in the State of Louisiana as a result of "[u]nprofessional conduct."

Dr. Jaikishen denies the allegations herein, but as evidenced by his subscription hereto, Dr. Jaikishen, without admitting any liability or violation of federal or state law or regulation, and for purposes of this Consent Order only, acknowledges that such information would provide the DOI with a reasonable basis to initiate formal administrative proceedings against his license pursuant to the Louisiana Medical Practice Act, constituting cause for such action against the physician's license to practice medicine in the state of Louisiana as the Board may deem appropriate.

Recognizing his right to written notification of any charges that may be asserted against him as a result of this investigation, as well as the right to administrative adjudication of such charges, at which time he would be entitled to be represented by legal counsel, to call witnesses and to present evidence in defense or in mitigation of the charges made and to a decision thereon by the Board based upon written findings of fact and conclusions of law, pursuant to La. Rev. Stat. §§49:951 et seq., Dr. Jaikishen, nonetheless, hereby waives his rights to notice, formal adjudication and written decision and, pursuant to La. Rev. Stat. §49:955(D), consents to entry of the Order set forth hereinafter. Furthermore, Dr. Jaikishen acknowledges that he hereby waives any right to which he may be entitled pursuant to the Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act, La. Rev. Stat. §§49:951 et seq., or to which he otherwise may be afforded by any law to contest his agreement to or the force and effect of the Board's investigation or this document in any court or other forum. By his subscription hereto, Dr. Jaikishen also hereby authorizes the DOI to present this Consent Order to the Board for its consideration and to fully disclose to and discuss with the Board the nature and results of the investigation, and he waives any objection to such disclosures under La. Rev. Stat. §49:960. Dr. Jaikishen expressly acknowledges that the disclosure of such information to the Board by the DOI shall be without prejudice to the DOI's authority to proceed with the filing and adjudication of any administrative charges that may subsequently be filed in this matter against him, or to the Board's capacity to adjudicate such complaint should the Board decline to approve this Consent Order.

Based upon the information provided and the recommendation of the DOI, the Board has concluded that its responsibility to insure the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of this state, pursuant to La. Rev. Stat. §37:1261, will be effectively served by entry of the Order set forth hereinafter by consent. Accordingly, in consideration of the forgoing and pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by La. Rev. Stat. §37:1285 and La. Rev. Stat. §49:955(D);

IT IS ORDERED that Jay P. Jaikishen, M.D., is OFFICIALLY REPRIMANDED for the conduct described herein above.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Jaikishen's continuing exercise of rights and privileges to engage in the practice of medicine in the State of Louisiana, as evidenced by

² Pursuant to La. R.S. §37:1285A(14), the Board may suspend, revoke, or impose probation or other restrictions on the license of an individual licensed to practice medicine in the State of Louisiana as a result of "[c]ontinuing or recurring medical practice which fails to satisfy the prevailing and usually accepted standards of medical practice in this state."

Certificate No. 08029R, shall be conditioned upon and subject to his acceptance of and strict compliance with the following terms and conditions and restrictions:

- 1. Attendance at Approved Seminar Professionalism and Medical Ethics. Within six (6) months from the effective date of this Order, Dr. Jaikishen shall provide written confirmation that he has attended and successfully completed one or more courses of study in the areas of professionalism and medical ethics. All courses required by this provision shall be comprehensive in nature (greater than 20 credit hours) and shall be acceptable to and pre-approved in writing by the Board or its designee.
- 2. Continuing Medical Education Skin and Soft Tissue Infections. If he has not already done so, within one year from the effective date of this Order, Dr. Jaikishen shall provide written confirmation that he has attended and successfully completed one or more courses of study, acceptable to the Board or its designee, in the treatment of skin and soft tissue infections.
- **3. Payment of fine.** Dr. Jaikishen shall, within ninety (90) days of the effective date of this Order, pay to the Board a fine in the amount of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any violation or failure of strict compliance with any of the terms and conditions set forth in this Order by Dr. Jaikishen shall be deemed adequate and sufficient cause, upon proof of such violation or failure, for the revocation and cancellation of Dr. Jaikishen's license to practice medicine in the State of Louisiana or for such other action as the Board may deem appropriate, as if such violations were enumerated among the causes provided in La. Rev. Stat. § 37:1285.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Consent Order shall be, and shall be deemed to be, a public record.
