

LOUISIANA STATE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

In Re: Dr. Gordon S. Bowers, M.D.

The Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners received information that Dr. Gordon S. Bowers, M.D. had been convicted of making false statements on certain income tax returns in violation of 26 USC 7206(1) in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Louisiana in proceedings numbered CR 77-1004. Based on such information, the Board scheduled a hearing in order to determine whether or not just cause existed for disciplinary action as provided for in Louisiana Revised Statutes 37:1285(1).

Prior to the date of such hearing, Dr. Bowers notified the Board that he waived the necessity for a formal hearing and agreed to enter into the following consent Judgment.

CONSENT JUDGMENT

Dr. Gordon S. Bowers' license to practice medicine in the State of Louisiana, as evidenced by Certificate No. 8755, is hereby suspended from the date hereof until the date of full compliance with and completion of the sentence imposed upon him by the Federal Court in proceedings No. 77-1004. This order of suspension is also hereby stayed for a like period of time and Dr. Bowers is allowed to practice medicine during such period of probation subject to the following probationary terms and conditions:

A.

That he comply with all of the provisions of the Medical Practice Act and the rules and regulations of the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners.

B.

That he successfully fulfills and complies with all of the terms and conditions of probation imposed on him by the United States District Court in proceedings No. 77-1004.

Any violation of the foregoing probationary terms and conditions will result in the immediate suspension of Dr. Bowers' license to practice medicine in the State of Louisiana without the need for further proceedings.
