STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT

THIS STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT is made and executed by and between Andrew Jackson Lanier, Jr., M.D., ("Dr. Lanier") a person of the full age of majority residing at 7721 Roundrock Road, Dallas, Texas, 75248, and the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners (the "Board"), an agency of the State of Louisiana, within the Department of Health and Hospitals, having its principal office at Suite 100, 830 Union Street, New Orleans, Louisiana, 70112.

Whereas, Dr. Lanier is a physician duly licensed to practice medicine in the state of Louisiana as of the date hereof, also holds a medical licensure in the State of Texas; and

Whereas, in connection with his application to the Board for renewal of his license to practice medicine in the state of Louisiana for the 1994 calendar year, Dr. Lanier has acknowledged that he has suffered from a condition which could reasonably be expected to affect his ability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients, advising, more particularly, that as of November 1993 he was being treated for bipolar disorder, type II, under the care of Alan Koenigsberg, M.D., Plano, Texas, and had not, since June 30, 1993, engaged in the practice of medicine; and

Whereas, in lieu of further inquiry or investigation of Dr. Lanier's condition or status at this time toward determining whether formal administrative proceedings are warranted, as Dr. Lanier is currently neither located nor practicing medicine in the state of Louisiana, Dr. Lanier and the Board mutually desire to enter into an agreement providing for Dr. Lanier to furnish the Board with written notice prior to relocating to and/or engaging in the practice of medicine in the state of Louisiana.

NOW, THEREFORE, Dr. Lanier hereby covenants, stipulates and agrees with the Board as follows:

A. Dr. Lanier shall not hereafter engage in the practice of medicine in the state of Louisiana unless and until: (i) he has given the Board not less than 90 days prior written notice of his intent to practice medicine in Louisiana; (ii) he has authorized Alan Koenigsberg, M.D., and such other physicians as have treated him within the prior two years to provide records, informations, reports and opinions to the Board on Dr. Lanier's then-current medical and psychiatric status and his fitness and ability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients; and (iii) the Board shall have provided Dr. Lanier with written confirmation authorization the initiation of his practice of medicine in the state of Louisiana.

B. Any violation of the foregoing stipulation and agreement by Dr. Lanier shall be deemed adequate and sufficient cause for the suspension or revocation of Dr. Lanier's license to practice medicine in the state of Louisiana, or for such other disciplinary action as the Board may deem appropriate.
