CONSENT

ORDER

for Renewal of
Medical Licensure

This matter is before the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners (hereinafter "Board") on the application of Sharon Ann Pancoast, M.D. ("Dr. Pancoast") for renewal of medical licensure in the State of Louisiana.

On September 26, 1985 Dr. Pancoast informally appeared before the Board to explain the circumstances out of which Dr. Pancoast was arrested, charged and convicted of illegal distribution of controlled substances.

After considering the statement of Dr. Pancoast at this informal appearance, the Board is of the opinion that the application for renewal of medical licensure should be

GRANTED, on a probationary basis, said probation subject to the following terms and condition:

1. The medical license of Dr. Sharon Ann Pancoast will remain on probation until her satisfactory completion of her residency training in Virginia;

2. In order to have the probationary condition of licensure removed Dr. Pancoast is to personally appear before the Board at the conclusion of her residency, and at that time shall present written certification from an appropriate authority attesting to her satisfactory and unconditional completion of her residency training;

3. The certification required in No. 2, above, shall state that Dr. Pancoast, during the tenure of her residency, was not made the subject of any disciplinary action by any Board, committee or other supervising authority;

4. It shall be incumbent upon Dr. Pancoast to request a personal appearance before the Board at the conclusion of her residency.

5. Dr. Pancoast shall make this personal appearance required above prior to the resumption of the practice of medicine in the State of Louisiana.

6. Dr. Pancoast shall not violate any rules, regulation or statute of any hospital, clinic or state supervisory authority during the completion of her residency training.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any violation of the terms, conditions, and restrictions set forth hereinabove shall be deemed just cause for the revocation of the license issued to Sharon Ann Pancoast, M.D., or for such other disciplinary action as the Board deems appropriate, as if such violation were enumerated among the causes set forth in LSA-R.S. 37:1285.
