CONSENT ORDER

By Notice of November 11, 1981, the Louisiana State
Board of Medical Examiners ("Board) advised Wayne Shepard,
M.D. ("Dr. Shepard") of the institution of administrative
proceedings relative to alleged specified violations of the
Louisiana Medical Practice Act, to wit: "[p]rescribing, dispensing or administering habit-forming or other legally controlled substances in other than a legal or legitimate
manner," LSA-R.S. 37:1285(6); and "[p]rofessional or medical
incompetency." LSA-R.S. 37:1285(12). Formal hearing to adjudicate the alleged violations was scheduled for December 11, 1981.

Recognizing his right to have the specified charges adjudicated pursuant to LSA-R.S. 49:955-58, and to a Final Decision rendered upon written findings of fact and conclusions of law, Dr. Shepard, on the advice of and

together with his undersigned counsel, Hani E. Dehan, without admitting any violations of the Louisiana Medical Practice
Act, nonetheless, hereby waives his right to a formal
adjudication of the charges and, pursuant to LSA-R.S.
49:955D, consents to entry of the following order. Accordingly, in consideration of the foregoing, and pursuant to
the authority vested in the Board of LSA-R.S. 37:1285 and
LSA-R.S. 49:955D,

IT IS ORDERED that the license of Wayne Shepard, M.D., to practice medicine in the State of Louisiana as evidenced by Certificate No. 6387 be and the same is hereby placed on probation for a period of five years from the date hereof, subject to Dr. Shepard's acceptance of and compliance with the following probationary terms, conditions and restrictions:

- A. Wayne Shepard, M.D., shall not engage in the practice of medicine in the State of Louisiana from January 1, 1982 through June 30, 1982.
- B. Dr. Shepard shall forthwith, if he has not heretofore done so, close the medical office formerly maintained by him in Mooringsport, Louisiana and shall not hereafter resume practice at such location.
- C. Dr. Shepard shall surrender to the issuing authorities his Federal registration and State license to prescribe, administer and dispense controlled substances, and he shall not at any time hereafter, without limitation as to the terms of probation hereinabove ordered, prescribe, administer or dispense controlled substances, as defined, enumerated or included in 21 C.F.R. § 1308.11-.15 or LS2-R.S. 40:964, and any

substance which may hereafter be included in any controlled substance schedules by amendment or revision of the hereinabove cited regulations and statute.

Dationary terms, conditions and restrictions set forth herein shall be deemed just cause for the suspension or revocation of the medical licensure of Wayne Shepard, M.D., or for such other disciplinary action as the Board deems appropriate, as if such violation was enumerated among the causes provided in LSA-R.S. 37:1285; provided, however, that any disposition of the criminal proceeding entitled UNITED STATES OF AMERICA vs. DR. WAYNE SHEPARD, United States District Court, Western District of Louisiana, Shreveport Division, Criminal No. 81-50053-01 shall not be considered a violation of LSA-R.S. 37:1285(1) or of the probationary terms and conditions hereinabove set forth.
