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This matter is before the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners (the "Board") on the application of Christopher L. Wooley for an 18-month temporary permit as a respiratory therapy technician. While it appears from information available to the Board, as supplied by Mr. Wooley's application and otherwise, that the applicant is generally qualified for such permit, Mr. Wooley also acknowledges in his application that he has previously been twice convicted of felony crimes in Arizona state courts, most recently for aggravated assault, for which he was sentenced to 18 months imprisonment completed in January 1994.<sup>1</sup> Such convictions could constitute sufficient legal grounds for the Board to deny Mr. Wooley's application for a temporary permit under the Respiratory Therapy Practice Act.<sup>2</sup>

In consideration of all of the information and circumstances presented, however, the Board is persuaded that the public interest will be properly protected and served by the issuance to Mr. Wooley of a temporary permit as a respiratory therapy technician, subject to his acceptance of and compliance with appropriate terms and conditions. And by his subscription hereto, Mr. Wooley hereby consents to entry of the order set forth below and to issuance of a temporary permit pursuant thereto. Accordingly,

**IT IS ORDERED** that an 18-month temporary permit as a respiratory therapy technician in the state of Louisiana shall be issued to Christopher Lee Wooley, ON PROBATION, the issuance of such permit and Mr. Wooley's continuing maintenance of such permit being expressly conditioned upon and subject to his acceptance of and strict compliance with the following probationary terms and conditions:

(a) **Compliance with Law.** Mr. Wooley shall observe and maintain strict and full compliance with the provisions of the Respiratory Therapy Practice Act and the rules and regulations of the Board promulgated pursuant thereto.


(b) **Disclosure to Employers.** Before accepting or engaging in employment as a respiratory therapy technician, Mr. Wooley shall give full disclosure to his employer of his prior criminal convictions and the probationary status of his temporary permit.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that any violation of or failure of strict compliance with any of the restrictions set forth by this Order by Mr. Wooley shall be deemed adequate and sufficient cause, upon proof of such violation or failure, for the revocation of Mr. Wooley's temporary permit as a respiratory therapy technician in the state of Louisiana.


